### Locational knowledge

Locate the world's countries, using maps to focus on Europe (including the location of Russia) and North and South America, concentrating on their environmental regions, key physical and human characteristics.

Name and locate counties and cities of the United Kingdom, geographical regions and their identifying human and physical characteristics and key topographical features (including hills, mountains, coasts and rivers).

### Human and physical geography

Describe and understand key aspects of physical geography, including: climate zones and the water cycle.

Describe and understand key aspects of human geography, including: distribution of natural resources including energy, food, minerals and water.

### Geographical skills and fieldwork

Use maps, atlases, globes and to locate countries and describe features studied.

Use fieldwork to measure, record and present the human and physical features in the local area using a range of methods, plans and graphs.
