Dear parents/carers,

We are really looking forward to our Reception visit to the British Wildlife Centre this **Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> June**, it will build upon the learning we have been doing around living things. You may already know that we have had emails from the Centre about a lost hedgehog and the children have enjoyed helping out!

The Centre is only open to us on this day and we go around in our classes, led by one of the experts, which makes the learning very tailored for our children. They take us to see many animals in their own habitats including badgers, owls, otters, red squirrels, foxes, rats and hedgehogs.

Thank you to those parents who have volunteered to accompany us on this visit; without your help our visits would not be possible.

We will travel to the British Wildlife Centre on 2 coaches, which are fitted with seatbelts. We ensure that we have more than adequate adult supervision with a ratio of 1:6.

Your child will need:

- **A packed lunch in a named plastic bag with disposable drinks. (No lunch boxes please).**
- **NO NUTS or SESAME PLEASE**. We have a child severely allergic to these. So no pesto, hummus or Nutella and please check cereal bars and seeded bread.
- **School uniform, lightweight waterproof coat** if rain is expected. If we are lucky and it is sunny please provide a **named sun hat** and apply **sun cream** before the start of the day.

We will depart from school at approximately **9.00 am and return for 3.00pm**.

If you have any further queries please speak to your child's class teacher, particularly if your child suffers with travel sickness on coaches.

Please make sure you have returned the voluntary contributions letter and signed the consent form to enable your child to go on this visit.
