



Dear Parents/ Carers,

The children will be visiting Squires Garden Centre, Burwood Road, Hersham to link in with our learning about the local environment and observing how plants grow. The classes will visit on consecutive days as follows:

- Tuesday 6th March – Cygnets Class
- Wednesday 7th March – Goslings Class
- Thursday 8th March – Ducklings Class

On the appropriate day please take your child to Squires between 08.50 – 09.00am, drive into the car park and leave your child with their teacher outside the front entrance. Please ensure that your child does not run across the car park. We will put lunch boxes and reading folders into a car belonging to a member of staff or parent, which will be brought back to school later.

After the visit we will walk back to Burhill School using the pavement. We will all be wearing a set of high visibility jackets and will be accompanied by parent volunteers to assist us safely across the Burwood Road.

If it is a wet day please ensure your child brings a good waterproof jacket for walking back to school.

If you have volunteered to accompany us on the trip there will be a briefing meeting on Monday 5th March in the meeting room at 9:00am. Please go to the office to sign in beforehand. It is important that this meeting is attended.

If you wish to discuss any part of this visit please do not hesitate to speak to your child's class teacher.

If your child is due to attend breakfast club on the day of their visit, their teacher will collect them from breakfast club and drive them to Squires Garden Centre. A suitable booster seat will be used to ensure their safety. Please fill in the consent form below and return to your teacher at your earliest convenience.
